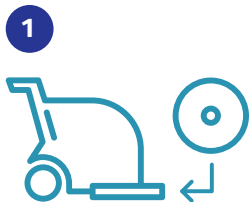

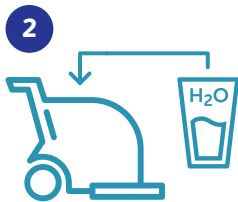

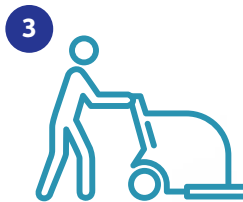
## TWISTER Guide
