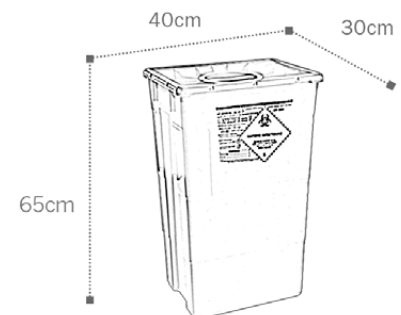

INSTRUCTIONS

► Placement of the lid without screw lid

1° step:

Push on two opposite corners



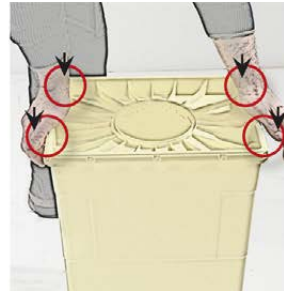
2° step:

Push on the other two opposite corners



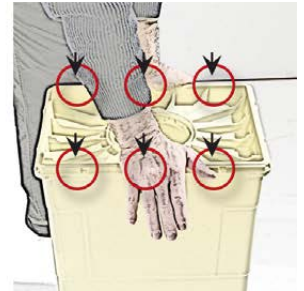
3° step:

Push on the edge of the short sides and insert the clips



4° step:

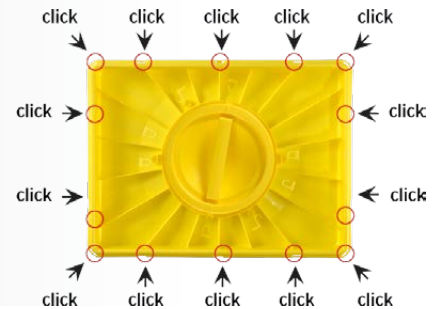
Push on the edge of the long sides and insert the clips



A sound ensures that the clip has been correctly inserted and the clip can be seen in the edge of the lid



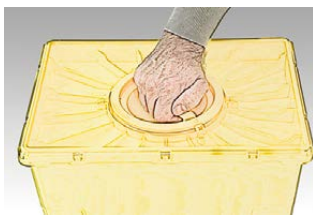
The lid is sealed on the perimeter of the container



► Temporary closure

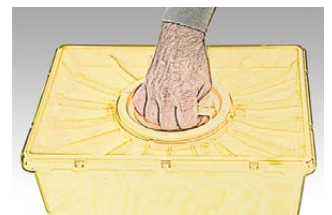
Insertion

a) place the screw lid on position as indicated on the lid



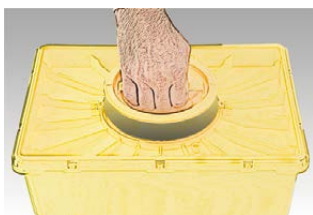
Temporary closure

b) Turn the screw lid to the left or to the right as indicated on the lid



► Permanent closure

a) take off the screw lid



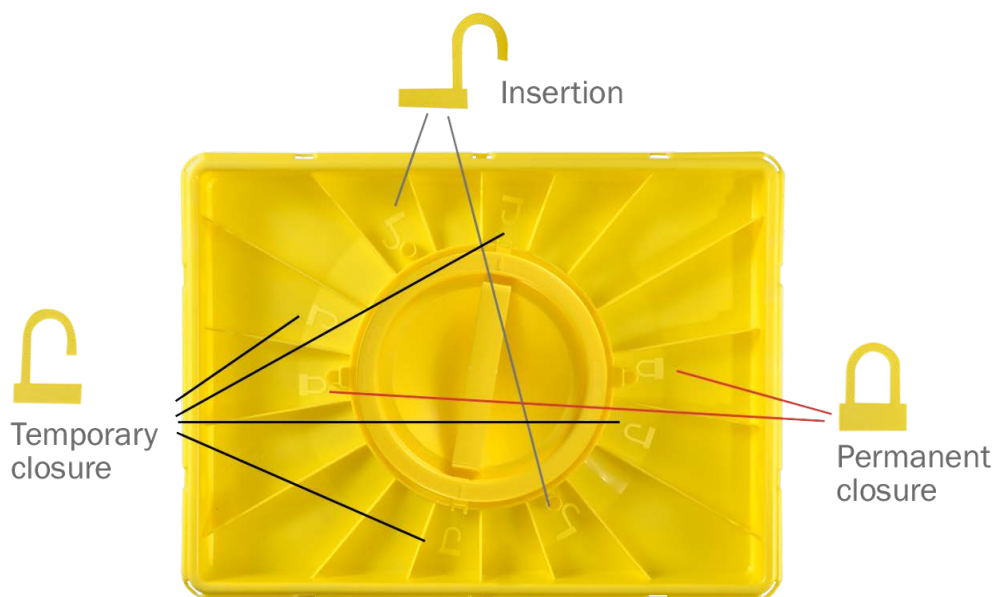
b) place the screw lid on the indicated position



c) press the screw lid firmly until it clicks



► Icons on lid SC DUO



The container is watertight thanks to the glue on the screw lid



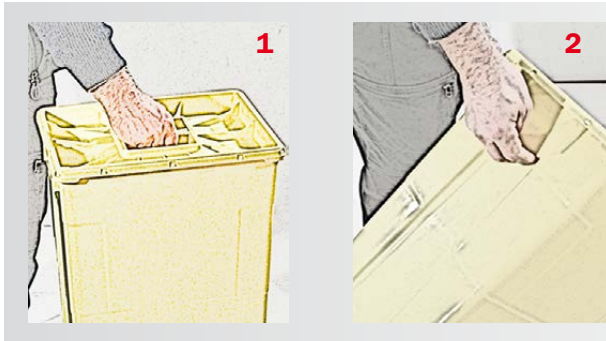
DISPOSAL

- Once full, the container must be disposed according to current law. If incinerated, the container does not release any toxic emission.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Use the container only with its own lid
- Make sure the lid is securely fastened
- Do not exceed the filling level
- Do not try to reopen the sealed container
- Do not try to recover objects inside the container

TRANSPORT OF THE CONTAINER IN DEFINITIVE CLOSURE



1 With the central handle

2 With the sides handles

WARNING: With lid SC DUO, use the central handle only with screw lid in permanent closure.
Do not use the central handle of the screw lid in temporary closure

ADVANTAGES

- ▶ High shock resistance at both low and high temperature
- ▶ High perforation resistance
- ▶ Easy to use
- ▶ Safe permanent closure
- ▶ No noxious gas released during the incineration process
