




## ScalpelCric

ScalpelCric has been developed to match the latest recommendations from the DAS (Difficult Airway Society) 2015 guidelines. Based on the simple description of "**stab**, **twist**, **bougie**, **tube**" the ScalpelCric is meant to facilitate the execution of the scalpel technique.







Adjustable flange
Thin walled, low pressure cuff
Smooth tip for ease of insertion
